If a child can read at grade level by 3rd grade, he/she will continue to read at grade level throughout his./her academic career. A child who succeeds in school will remain there, earning a chance at a better job and a better life in the years ahead. A child who lacks early exposure to reading often suffers with low self-esteem, struggles academically, and is at higher risk for substance abuse, teen pregnancy, and delinquency.
